For example: 2 quarters, 1 dime, 3 nickels and 4 pennies.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>3</b></p> <p>Set up a store in your home. Practice counting money by purchasing items from the store.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>4</b></p> <p>Look at a digital clock 3 times today. Draw a picture of an analog clock and show the time. Be sure that each time the minutes are different.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;"><div style="text-align: center;"> 3:00</div><div style="text-align: center;"> 9:45</div></div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>5</b></p> <p>Use a ruler or tape measure to measure 3 things in your home.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>6</b></p> <p>Practice adding two 3 digit numbers without regrouping. Make up your own problems.</p> <p>For example:</p> $\begin{array}{r} 112 \\ + 602 \\ \hline \end{array}$

<p><b>7</b></p> <p>Practice adding two 3 digit numbers with regrouping. Remember, if it adds up to 9 everything is fine. 10 or more take the extra next door. For example: <math>\begin{array}{r} 219 \\ + 423 \end{array}</math></p>	<p><b>8</b></p> <p>Practice measurement by following a recipe to bake or cook something with a grown-up!</p>	<p><b>9</b></p> <p>Practice counting to 1000 by 1's, 5's, and 10's.</p>
