Remember: 12 inches equals 1 foot.</p>
<p>4</p> <p>Coin recognition: Find a penny, nickel, dime and quarter and write down 3 things that you see on each individual coin.</p>	<p>5</p> <p>Construct shapes using play-dough, clay, toothpicks, pipe cleaners, etc. and identify the attributes</p>	<p>6</p> <p>Creating rectangular arrays: You can use coins, cheerios, marshmallows, etc. How many rows? How many in each row? This array has 2 rows and 5 in each row.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">xxxxx xxxxx</p>
