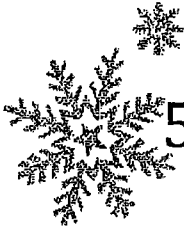

They did not make a big snowman or a small snowman.

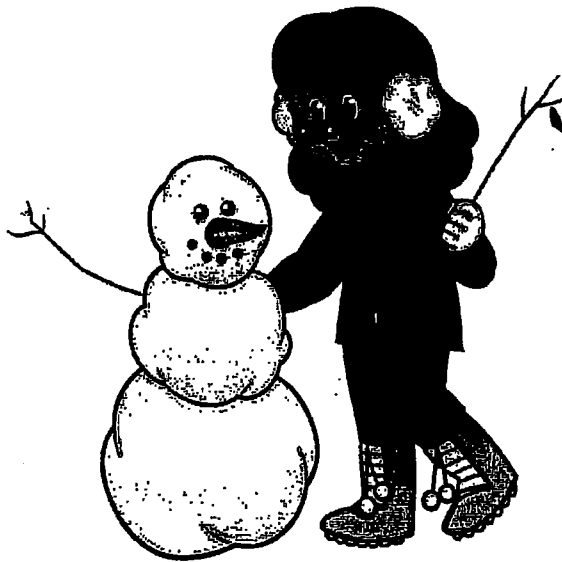
They made three snow kids.

Seconds later, the friends were making...and throwing...snowballs!

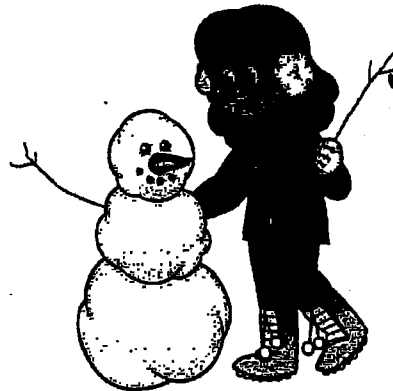

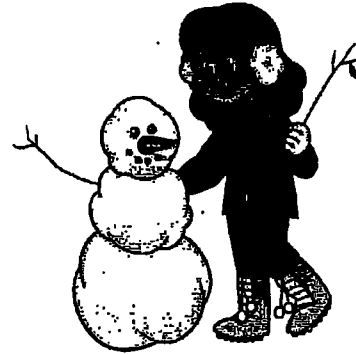

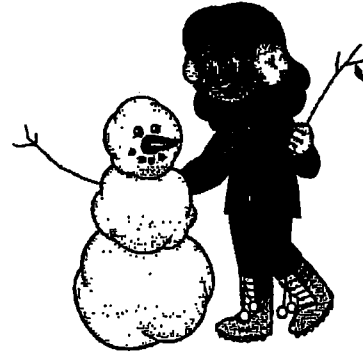

Ian Builds a Snowman

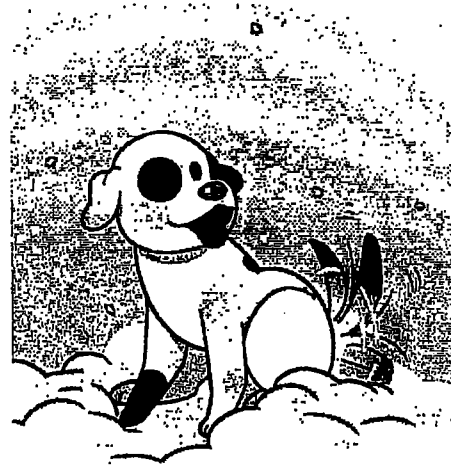

"Oh well." Anna laughed. "You know what that means." She rolled some snow into a small snowball.

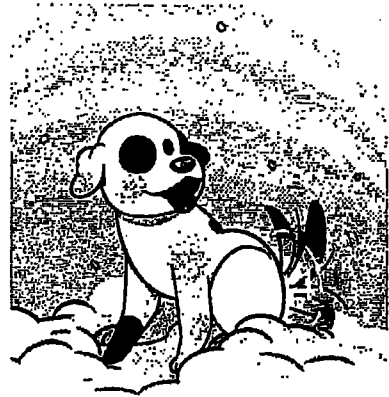
Zing! It flew past Ian's ears. Ian ducked behind a tree.

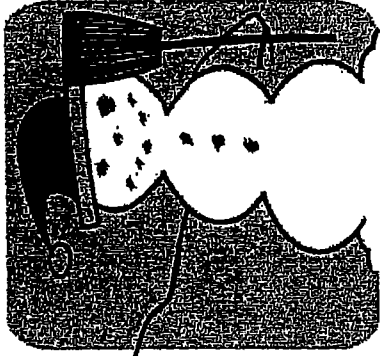
