Ridgewood Local School District served over 870 students on Thursday, April 2. Our staff enjoyed the opportunity to see so many student smiles. It was truly priceless. We will continue to serve student meals on the following date and times:

Tuesday, April 7: 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. at RMS as well as our p.m. bus routes.

Students do **NOT** have to be present to receive student meals. The Federal government waived that requirement. We ask that someone be at your stop at the p.m. drop off time to receive a student meal. Please do not enter the bus. You need to remain at the designated place of safety. Please be flexible within 10 minutes of the stop times. Those using RMS curbside service need to remain in the vehicle to receive the meal. If you are able, please pop your trunk and we will place it in there. If not we will place it in the passenger front seat. Please do not have anyone in that seat. Again these meals are free and students will receive a breakfast and lunch at the same time. We can serve any child from birth to 18 years of age from any district. We are willing to serve children meals that are at babysitters or daycares.
