Update, July 6, 2020

2020-2021 School Year

We are very excited that we will be able to have traditional face to face instruction with our student in our physical buildings on Wednesday, August 26. Governor DeWine, during his press conference on Thursday, July 2 provided COVID-19 Health and Prevention Guidance for Ohio K-12 schools to provide a framework for Ohio school districts to reopen our buildings while also helping our students and staff reduce the risk of exposure and prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our communities. The framework is based on guidance and best practices for:

1) Assessing symptoms.

Ridgewood Local School District staff and students will be expected to complete a
wellness check which includes symptoms and temperature prior to attending our
school's property. Staff and students who have a temperature over 100 degrees or
COVID-19 symptoms will be required to stay home.

2) Increased Sanitation.

- Ridgewood Local School District will implement recommended safety protocols to the highest degree possible. Deep Cleaning and disinfecting will take place during and after the school day.
- Ridgewood Local School Buildings will have hand sanitation stations located at entrances of our school buildings as well as classrooms.

3) Social Distancing.

- Student entering the school building in the morning will be going directly to their homeroom/1st period class. Students will eat breakfast in their classroom and/or socially distanced cafeteria.
- Teachers will move from class to class when possible.
- Student meals will be eaten in the classroom and/or socially distanced cafeteria.

4) Face Coverings/Mask.

- Ridgewood Local School District staff will be wearing face coverings.
- Governor DeWine guidelines recommend students in 3rd grade and higher wear a face mask unless they are unable to do so for a health or developmental reason.
- Ridgewood Local School District will be working on guidelines for student face coverings/mask. We have yet to determine when and where students will need to wear a mask.

We have been working on our own Re-Opening Guidelines and General Principles for the past month. We have provided a few details under each framework above. We will now utilize Governor DeWine's COVID-19 Health and Prevention Guidance for Ohio K-12 Schools as well as the Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level Guidelines for the public to finalize our Reopening Guidelines and General Principles. We are hoping to have this available within the next 10 days. We will post it on the website and app.

We are aware that some parents and guardians might not feel comfortable sending their child back to a regular schedule school day for a variety of reasons. We will work with you and your child to provide remote learning. Muskingum Valley Health Centers (MVHC) has partnered with Ridgewood Local School District to provide a School-Based Health Center located on the campus of Ridgewood Local Schools to provide complete healthcare and behavioral health services to students during school hours. The School-Based Health Center will also provide care to the community after school hours by appointment. The School-Based Health Center will operate Monday-Friday and is scheduled to open this August.

Muskingum Valley Health Centers (MVHC) offers a School Health Program centered on providing comprehensive primary care services including pediatric, adolescent, and behavioral health care to students. This community-based model of care is designed to provide affordable, age-appropriate, confidential, convenient care to students. MVHC medical staff and providers will treat illness, as well as providing preventative care and well-child services.

Ridgewood Local Schools New Athletic Complex

Ridgewood Local School District's new athletic complex is near complete. The new athletic complex will consist of locker room, weight room/fitness center, multipurpose center and a meeting room.
