

## Update, April 20, 2020

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### Food Service---Coronavirus

Tuesday, April 21: 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. at RMS as well as our p.m. bus routes.

- Bus Delivery will only take place on Tuesday, April 21. We will be sending six meals on the bus for Tuesday, April 14.

Thursday, April 23: 11a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. at RMS—**Curbside service only.**

Those that receive bus delivery on Tuesdays, may receive curbside meals.

Students do **NOT** have to be present to receive student meals. The Federal government waived that requirement. We ask that someone to be at your stop at the p.m. drop off time to receive a student meal. Please do not enter the bus. You need remain at designated place of safety. Please be flexible within 10 minutes of the stop times. Those using RMS curbside service need to remain in the vehicle to receive the meal. If you are able, please pop your trunk and we will place it in there. If not we will place it in the passenger front seat. Please do not have anyone in that seat. Again these meals are free and students will receive a breakfast and lunch at the same time. We can serve any child from birth to 18 years of age from any district. We are willing to serve children meals that are at babysitters or daycares. The weekly lessons will have a section where the parent/guardian can sign to verify their child has completed the activities to the best of their ability. We would like the parent/guardian to email it back to your child's first period teacher. If you are unable to email the weekly lessons back to the school, you may

- 1) Email the following information to your child's first period teacher: child's name, child's grade, parent/guardian name and statement indicating my child has completed the weekly lesson for April 13 and 20 to their best ability.
- 2) Call your child's school building and leave a message with the following information or email the following information: child's name, child's grade, parent/guardian name and statement indicating my child has completed the weekly lesson for the week of April 13 and 20 to their best ability.

**All Call** system allows our teachers to communicate with their students about their lessons and other information. RES teachers will use the all call system at least once during this week. RMS and RHS teachers will be using the following schedule:
