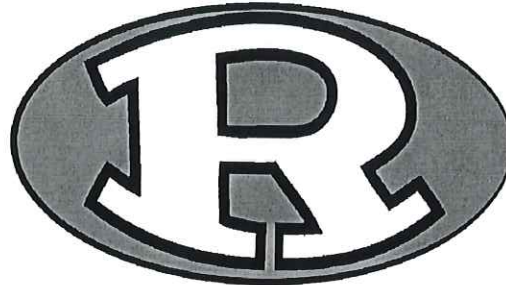

Public Participation at Board Meetings

All meetings of the Board will be open to the public. In order for the Board to fulfill its obligation to complete the planned agenda in an effective and efficient fashion, a maximum of 30 minutes of public participation will be permitted at each meeting. Each person addressing the Board will give his/her name and address. If several people wish to speak, each person will be allotted three minutes until the total time of 30 minutes is used. During that period no person may speak twice until all who desire to speak have had the opportunity to do so. Persons desiring more time should follow the procedure of the Board to be placed on the regular agenda. Generally, the Board will act on items on the regular agenda. Other items will be given consideration for future action. Any complaint against school employees must follow the district complaint procedure. The period of public participation may be extended by a vote of the majority of the Board.
